LOCAL LAW NO. 15 OF THE YEAR 2006

A local law amending Section 27-04 of Ordinance No. 27 titled "Dogs"

Be it enacted by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Park as follows:

Local law amending Section 27-04 of Ordinance No. 27 titled Dogs.

Any dog found running at large within the Village may be seized by any Dog Warden, peace officer or animal warden and may be confined and impounded in the public pound maintained by the Town of Hempstead. Any such dog so impounded shall be confined for a period of five (5) days and may be redeemed by the owner upon proof of license and by paying a \$60.00 fee of the cost of the seizure. If the seizure occurs on weekends, holidays or before 9:00 a.m. or after 3:00 p.m. on days in which the Village is open, the owner must pay an additional \$220.00, for a total of \$280.00 for the cost of the seizure. If not so redeemed, the owner shall forfeit all title to the dog and the dog shall be sold or destroyed by the keeper of the pound or other authorized representative. This fee may be amended by resolution by the Board of Trustees.

This local law shall take effect immediately.
