VILLAGE OF ISLAND PARK LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1990

A local law prohibiting encumbrance of public streets, highways, etc.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Park as follows:

- Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to encumber, block, build upon or in any other way interfere with access to and use of any street, road, highway, thoroughfare or sidewalk which is shown as such on the deed of dedication of said streets and highways.
- Section 2. Any violation of this local law shall be deemed to be disorderly conduct punishable upon a conviction by a fine of not more than \$100.00 for the first offense and not more than \$300.00 for any further offense.
