VILLAGE OF ISLAND PARK LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1996

A local law entitled regulating tow car operations and towing with in the Village of Island Park

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Park as follows:

Section 1. General Provisions

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive along any street or bridge in the Village of Island Park and solicit towing work. Solicitation of towing work by the operator or the occupant of a tow car while parked on any street or bridge is also prohibited. A tow car operator shall not proceed to the scene of a disabled motor vehicle without having been requested or notified to do so by the owner or his authorized representative or the police. Responding to a call merely upon notification from gas station attendants, taxicab drivers or other unauthorized persons shall be considered in violation of this provision.

Section 2:. Penalties for offenses

- A. An offense against any provision of Section 1 hereof shall be guilty of a class B misdemeanor, which shall be punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500) or imprisonment [or a period not exceeding three (3) months for each such offense, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day of continued violation shall constitute a separate additional violation.
- B. In addition to the penalties provided herein, an offense against this local law may result in the suspension or revocation of the tow car owners or driver's license.

Section 3 Effective date

This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
