VILLAGE OF ISLAND PARK LOCAL LAW NO. 3 of the Year 1976

Entitled "A Local Law regulating the hours during which gardening and power equipment may be operated."

Be it enacted by the Board to Trustees of the Village of Island Park as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. No person or persons, firm, association or corporation shall do, perform, cause, suffer or permit any of the following acts:

- a) operate any mower or power lawn mower or other power equipment earlier than 8a.m. in the morning on any day.
- (b) place or scatter any garbage, refuse, cutting, leaves, wood or other materials upon any public place or private property.

<u>Section 2</u>. Every person convicted of a violation of any provisions of any provisions of this local law shall be punished by and subjected to a fine of not more than \$250.00 for each violation. In addition to the foregoing penalties, it is ordained that any violation of this local law or any provisions thereof, shall constitute disorderly conduct and the person violating the same, shall be and hereby is declared to be a disorderly person.

Section 3. The foregoing local law shall take effect according to law.
