## VILLAGE OF ISLAND PARK LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF THE YEAR 2006

A local law amending Sections 4 and 5 of Ordinance No. 15 Concerning Application Fee for Banners, Signs, etc. in the Village of Island Park

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Park as follows:

Section 1: Sections 4 and 5 of Ordinance No. 15 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4:

After obtaining the consent of the Board of Trustees for the erection of any sign, banner or other emblem or insignia as set forth in the foregoing sections of this Law no person or persons, firm, association or corporation shall erect such sign until payment of Fifty (\$50) Dollars has been made to the Village Clerk and a written permit received from said Village Clerk.

Section 5:

Any person or persons, firm, association or corporation violating any provision of this Local Law, or any part thereof, shall be liable for and forfeit to pay a penalty of not more than One hundred (\$100) Dollars for each violation thereof, for the use of said Village. Any violation of this Local Law, or arty part thereof, shall constitute disorderly conduct, and any person violating the same shall be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.

Section 2: This local law shall take effect upon proper filing with the Secretary of State.
