VILLAGE OF ISLAND PARK LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 1978

A local law amending Village Ordinance No. 27 regulating the conduct of dog

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Park as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Village Ordinance No. 27 is hereby amended by adding hereto a new Section 27—05 (A) to read as follows:

Section 27-05 (A): No owner or person in charge of any dog shall permit such dog to urinate or delicate on any highway, street, road, sidewalk, parking area, shopping area, place of amusement, playground, park, beach, or on any public property or private property except upon the property of such owner or except on that portion of a street lying between the curb lines which shall be used to curb such dog under the following conditions:

- 1. The person who so curbs such dog shall immediately remove all feces deposited by such dog in a sanitary manner.
- 2. The feces so removed shall be disposed of by such person in a sanitary manner.

SECTION 2. Section 27-06 thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 27-06: Any owner or person violating any of the provisions of this local law shall be liable for and forfeit and pay penalties of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$250.00 for each violation thereof.

SECTION 3. This local law shall take effect according to law
