ORDINANCE NO. 20

INDECENT OR IMMODEST ACTS

Section 1

No person or persons shall disrobe in vehicles or commit any lewd, wanton, indecent, immodest, obscene, or filthy act or be guilty of any lewd, wanton, indecent, immodest, obscene or filthy gesture or conduct in any street, highway or public place in the Village of Island Park. (Amended October 18, 1931.)

Section 2

Any person or persons violating this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be liable for and forfeit and pay a penalty of not less than Ten (\$10) Dollars nor more than Fifty (\$50) Dollars for each violation thereof for the use of said Village. Any violation of this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall constitute disorderly conduct, and any person violating this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.

Section 3

No person or persons shall loiter or appear upon any of the streets, highways, boardwalk, stores, or other public places within the Village, excepting the beach or some direct route to the beach when such person or persons do not loiter, or upon any conveyances of any nature or description thereon, when attired in a bathing suit or other like apparel, unless such person or persons shall wear outside and over such bathing suit or apparel a bathrobe, cloak or other garment which shall extend downward at least to a point six inches below the knee and which shall be buttoned so as to fully enclose the person, or when otherwise improperly attired, under the penalty of a fine of not more than Twenty-five (\$25) Dollars for each offense, or under penalty of being prosecuted as and being declared to be a disorderly person or both.
