### ORDINANCE NO. 29

# SUNDAY MOTION PICTURE EXHIBITIONS

#### Section 1

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2154 of the Penal Law of the State of New York, permission is hereby granted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Park, Nassau County, New York, to exhibit motion pictures within said Village, after two o'clock in the afternoon, on the first day of the week.

## Section 2

No moving pictures shall be exhibited within the Village of Island Park, Nassau County, New York, at hours other than those hereby permitted.

### Section 3

Any person or persons, firm, association or corporation violating this Ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be liable for and forfeit and pay a penalty of not less than ten (\$10) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100) dollars for each violation thereof for the use of said Village. Any violation of this Ordinance, or any part thereof, shall constitute disorderly conduct, and any person violating any provision of this Ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.
