

ORDINANCE NO. 34 A

TRAFFIC SIGNALS

Section 1

No person driving any motor vehicle, other vehicle, horse or other animal, or riding upon any motorcycle or bicycle, within the Village of Island Park, shall disobey any direction or signal given by colored lights at the intersection of any streets in said Village. A green light shall be the signal to proceed, an amber light shall be a caution signal, upon which to stop if the vehicle can reasonably do so before reaching the intersection; a red light shall be the signal to stop. No person driving any motor vehicle, other vehicle, horse or wagon, or riding upon any motorcycle or bicycle within the Village of Island Park, shall disobey any traffic direction displayed upon any traffic control light, unless otherwise directed by a traffic officer on duty (Amended November 20, 1958).

Section 2

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be liable for, and forfeit and pay a penalty of not less than two (\$2) dollars or more than twenty-five (\$25) dollars for the first offense and not less than ten (\$10) dollars or more than one hundred (\$100) dollars for the second offense, and in addition thereto, each of said violations shall constitute and is hereby declared a disorderly person.
