ORDINANCE NO. 36-A

RELATING TO PAVEMENT MARKINGS ON STREETS AND HIGHWAYS

Section 1

The pavement traffic lines and markings duly approved and adopted now or hereafter by the State Traffic Commission for State Highways are hereby approved and adopted as to all highways and streets within the corporate limits of the Village of Island Park, except State Highways, and all vehicular traffic using the said highways and streets shall be governed thereby where such signs and markings are used.

Section 2

Any person falling to obey any provision of this Ordinance or any marking, established pursuant to this Ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of violating this Ordinance and shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 91 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York for violation of Article 6 of said Vehicle and Traffic Law, as follows: upon conviction, may be punished for the first offense by a fine, not exceeding Ten (\$10) Dollars, and for the second offense by a fine of not less than Ten (\$10) Dollars or more than Twenty-Five (\$25) Dollars or by imprisonment for not less than two or more than fifteen days. The third of any subsequent offense within one year may be punishable by a fine, not exceeding One Hundred (\$100) Dollars or by imprisonment, not exceeding six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
