

ORDINANCE NO. 47

BONFIRES AND CARE THEREOF

Section 1

No person or persons, firm, association or corporation shall set fire to, burn or cause or permit to be burned or set fire to, any material of any kind whatsoever within 20 feet of any building or structure whatsoever unless the same shall be burned or set fire to in a receptacle constructed of fire proof material and covered with a cover constructed of fire proof material, nor shall any person, firm, association or corporation build a bonfire or burn any material of any kind whatsoever or cause or permit such fire to be built out of doors at any place in the village of Island Park without a permit from a fire commissioner of the said Village and unless there is some person of at least the age of sixteen (16) years attending the said bonfire and watching the same to prevent any damage resulting therefrom. No person or persons, firm, association or corporation shall build a bonfire or burn any materials of any kind or cause or permit such fire to be built at any place out of doors within the Village of Island Park, between the hours of 9 P.M. and 6 A.M Standard Time.

Section 2.

Any person or persons, firm, association or corporation violating this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be liable for and forfeit and pay a penalty of not less than twenty-five (\$25) dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100) Dollars for each violation thereof, for the use of the Village of Island Park. Any violation of this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall constitute disorderly conduct, and any person violating this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.
