

ORDINANCE NO. 54

CESSPOOLS & SCAVENGERS

Section 1

No person or persons shall engage in the business of scavenger or cleaning cesspools within the Incorporated Village of Island Park without a license. Any person may obtain a license for the business of scavenger or cleaning cesspools within said Village upon making an application in writing to the Village Clerk therefore and upon paying a license fee of \$10.00 which is the fee thereby fixed therefore and which license shall be issued by the Mayor and countersigned by the Village Clerk and shall have endorsed thereon the receipt of the Treasurer of the Village of Island Park, showing payment to him of such license fee. A license when so issued shall permit the licensee to employ or use only one vehicle for such business of scavenger or cleaning cesspools and an additional license with an additional fee as prescribed for the original license shall be required for each additional vehicle so used or employed in the business of scavenger or cleaning cesspools.

Section 2

Any license for the business of scavenger or cleaning cesspools issued under the provisions of this ordinance shall expire on the 30th day of April next succeeding the date of the issuance of such license. Such license may be renewed annually in the same manner and upon payment of the same annual fee as provided in Section 1 for its issuance to take effect on the first day in May of each year.

Section 3

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable for and forfeit and pay a penalty of \$25.00 for each violation thereof for the use of said Village. Any violation of this ordinance or any part thereof, shall constitute disorderly conduct, and any person or persons violating any part thereof shall be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.

Section 4

This ordinance shall take effect on the 11th day of September, 1932 and shall not apply to licenses which have been issued and have not expired at the time of its taking effect.
