

ORDINANCE NO. 62

DISROBING IN PUBLIC

It shall be unlawful for any person to disrobe for the purpose of bathing or swimming, except under the shelter of a house, tent or shed, reasonably protected from observation of the public.

Any person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 for each offense. Any violation of this ordinance shall constitute disorderly conduct and any person violating the same shall be a disorderly person.
