ORDINANCE NO. 66

Section 1

Be it resolved that no person operating a boat of any kind whatsoever within that body of water known as the Island Park Canal shall operate at a rate of speed greater than 4 miles an hour and be it further resolved that any person operating a boat of any kind whatsoever in the Island Park Harbor or the Island Park Canal shall operate same in a careful and prudent manner and in such a manner so as not to endanger any person or persons using said waters of any other boats in said waters.

Section 2

Any person violating this ordinance shall be liable and forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding twenty-five dollars. Said violation shall constitute and is hereby declared to be disorderly conduct and any person violating this ordinance shall be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.
