

## ORDINANCE NO, 47-A

### BURNING OF LEAVES, DEBRIS AND SIMILAR MATERIALS

#### Section 1

It is hereby declared and found that the burning of leaves, trees, bushes, paper, rubbish, debris or any other combustible material in an open fire constitutes a health and fire hazard and causes contamination of air with resultant harmful effect upon persons, and a danger to the destruction of property by fire.

#### Section 2

The term "open fire" as used in this ordinance shall mean any fire lighted and maintained other than a fire in stove , furnace or incinerator designed and constructed for the burning of material. The term "open fire" shall not include barbecue pits, outdoor fireplaces and grills designed and when sane are used for the purpose of cooking food for private and home consumption and shall not include the use of a fire in a fireplace.

#### Section 3

It shall be unlawful for any person to light, permit or maintain an open fire in or upon any premises streets, roads, highways, sidewalks or public places within the Village.

#### Section 4

The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to the burning of material by any agency of the Village when such burning is done under the supervision of an official in charge of such agency.

#### Section 5

Any person or persons, firm, association or corporation violating this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be liable for and forfeit and pay a penalty of not less than ten (\$10) dollars nor more than fifty (\$50) dollars for each violation thereof, for the use of the Village of Island Park. Any violation of this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall constitute

disorderly conduct, and any person violating this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.
